- categories may be merged if there are less than three entries
- competitors may dance 2 consecutive age groups (see rule # 13)

****Levels:** Newcomer (first time competitor or less than 30 hrs of lessons), Pre-Bronze, Bronze 1, Full Bronze, Open Bronze, Pre-Silver, Silver 1, Full Silver, Open Silver, Pre-Gold, Gold 1, Open Gold

**** competitors may dance up to 3 consecutive levels and 1 open (see rule # 14)**

- In Pro/am divisions, Men will compete against the ladies if there are less than 3 entries of either sex in the event.
- Costumes may be worn in all categories however, no thongs are permitted.
- Materials danced must coincide with any NDCA approved step list.
- No lifts are permitted.

Pro/Am Championships

Age Divisions: A(18-34) B(35-54) C(55+)

Levels: Closed Bronze, Closed Silver, Closed Gold, Open Bronze, Open Silver, Open Gold

Pro/Am Scholarships (\$200 – \$150 - \$100)

Levels: Closed Bronze, Closed Silver

Age Divisions: A(19-45) B(46+)

Open Scholarship - All ages all levels

Rules for Championships and Scholarships

- Levels and ages may be merged in the event of insufficient entries
- Championships and Scholarships are unisex competitions.
- May enter only one age category
- May enter one closed division and one open division
- Must dance the corresponding single dances in the division and levels entered.
- Must dance the highest level in which single dances were entered.

Pro/Am & Amateur Solos

- May not exceed 2 ½ minutes
- music must be provided on an individual CD
- Lifts are permitted

Amateur Collegiate and Adult Single and Multi-Dance Events

Age Divisions: A(18-34) B(35-54) C(55+)

- Adult competitors may dance 2 consecutive age groups (see rule #13)
- Collegiate competitors dance in A category only, proof of age and valid school ID required.

Levels: Syllabus -2 dance - Bronze, Silver, Gold
Novice Open (3 dance) , Open Pre-Championship (4 dance),
Open Championship

- Competitors may dance up to 2 consecutive levels
- Costumes may be worn in all categories however, no thongs are permitted.
- Materials danced must coincide with any NDCA approved step list.
- No lifts are permitted.
- With the exception of Open International Championships (A division), all adult and collegiate Amateurs will compete in the same session as the corresponding Pro/Am Adult divisions.

Open Amateur Latin and Standard Championships (A division) will be Scholarship events

Awards: 1st \$300 - 2nd \$200 - 3rd \$100

**Championship entries fees are not included in the Collegiate Competitor Package

Collegiate Competitor Package

Only \$80 per couple includes a weekend pass for all competitive sessions including the Saturday night events and professional show, compete in up to 8 entries in single dance or multi-dance events within 2 consecutive levels up to the Pre-Champ Division. Proof of age and valid student ID required, meals and hotel not included.. Scheduled to dance during Amateur Events.

Rules

1. Entries must be made on New Jersey State Open entry forms
2. Names of both partners must be listed for entry to be accepted.
3. Juniors must dance in division entered.
4. No changes will be made at the event.
5. Parents will not be permitted in or around the line-up area.
6. NDCA costuming rules are recommended
7. Children are expected to be on their best behavior while attending the Competition.
8. Children are not permitted to run around or carry on in the Ballroom or the Hotel in general. Teachers must supervise the children at all times. Any complaints about a child or parent may result in the child being prohibited from dancing and evicted from the Competition area. No refunds will be made under these circumstances.

Rules and Regulations.

1. All persons attending this competition, whether as spectators, competitors or guest of officials, hereby release the Organizers, the NDCA, their officers, employees, volunteers, agents, and any other people connected with this event, from any and all liability for damage to or loss of personal property, sickness or injury from whatever source, legal entanglements, imprisonment, death or financial loss, which might occur while participating in this event. All attendees will be aware of the risks of participation, and understand that they participate at their own risk
2. No responsibility for the loss or theft of personal belongings left in the changing rooms, ballroom, practice spaces or any hotel rooms will be accepted by the Organizers, NDCA or the Hotel
3. All persons attending the competition shall be bound by the NDCA rules and attending the events are automatically obliged to adhere to them.
4. No video taping or filming will be allowed, however, a professional video company will be on hand to video your dancing
5. It is understood that anyone in the ballroom may be photographed or video taped and it may be shown elsewhere. Anyone attending this event consents to be photographed and/or video taped and waves any and all claims and rights to the use of the photos or videos.
6. All completed forms and full payment must be received by the deadline. **Payments must accompany entries.**
7. Entry fees must be paid before competing.
8. Entry fees do not include admission to the ballroom. Non-Package holders competing or spectating, will be required to purchase General Admission Tickets.
9. All categories and events are subject to a reasonable registration and the Organizers reserve the right to reduce by half, the advertised prize money, combine, merge or cancel any heats or events with insufficient entries.
10. All Professional and amateur couples must be registered with the NDCA. NDCA registration forms are available from www.ndca.org or Ms. Eleanor Wiblin, PO Box 22018, Provo, Utah 84602.

11. All cancellations must be made in writing to the organizers. Cancellations made up to 10 days prior to the event will receive a refund within 30 days after the event. A \$75 cancellation fee will be applied to all refunds. No refunds will be given within 10 days of the event. No substitutions of entries will be allowed. Absolutely no refunds will be given at the event. Refunds or exchanges cannot be made on plaques, trophies or general admission tickets.
12. The Chairman of Judges shall be responsible for decisions concerning ties or any problem arising over marks. Any questions or discrepancy of results are to be addressed immediately after the results of the event are given. The decision of the Chairman shall be final.
13. A student may enter a younger age category in addition to their normal age division, but not an older one.
14. A student may dance in three consecutive divisions; for example: Full Bronze Tango, Pre-Silver Tango and Silver one Tango, but not Full Silver Tango.
15. Teachers may not enter two students in the same category.
16. Collegiate must be under 25 years young and have a current valid ID card.
17. Costumes may be worn, but are not required in all categories. No thongs are permitted. It is recommended that children follow the NDCA costuming requirements.
18. If in the opinion of the organizers, a costume is deemed inappropriate, the competitor will have the option of changing costumes or withdrawing from the competition. No refunds will be issued in this situation. The organizers reserve the right to disqualify any competitor who fails to rectify a costuming warning.
19. The organizers reserve the right right to refuse admission to person or persons who have violated any of the above rules at any recognized NDCA event.
